

Minutes of the Village of Newburg Parks Commission

June 14, 2017 at 6:30p.m., Village Hall

The meeting of the Village of Newburg Parks Commission for Wednesday, June 14, 2017 was called to order. Roll Call of Parks Commission Members was taken with members Roger Zorn, Amy Juech, Mary Monday, Dave DeLuka, Lisa Gramoll as well as DPW Superintendent Waech was present.

Minutes

A motion was made by Roger Zorn and seconded by Dave DeLuka to approve the minutes of May 10, 2017 meeting, pending any additions or corrections. Motion passed 5-0.

New Business

1. Discussion of installation of dog waste stations at parks, DPW employees will evaluate the need
2. Committee to recess next meeting to visit Grotelueschen President's Park
3. Continuing discussions with YMCA operations at Holy Trinity Facility
4. Discussions with Riveredge Nature Center to co-chair a movie night in the parks
5. Park Inventory of benches, garbage receptacles, picnic tables, etc., garbage can tops are needed and need for recycle receptacles will be evaluated.

Unfinished Business

1. Disc golf discussions continue for Grotelueschen Presidents Park, Dave DeLuka is working with Eagle Scouts
2. Continued improvements at Freedom Park taking out two dying trees
3. Continuing discussions with YMCA and St. Johns building for community programs
4. Maintenance of ball diamond complete, working on grading issues still. Volleyball court tilled and net put in place, both at Doc Weber Park. Article in Bridges will ask for community input to add a dual use to the baseball diamond by adding soccer nets.
5. Waiting on another quote for resurfacing tennis court at Doc Weber Park, needs to be done and put into 2018 budget.
6. Received some prices for trees to be added to Grotelueschen Presidents Park, budget for after disc golf layout is complete
7. Discussion of walkway repairs and grading issues and possible widening to meet ADA compliance at Doc Weber Park. Conversation put on hold until discussion occur on putting a shelter in place before replacing walkway and putting a proper size walk way in to accommodate shelter use.
